CHURCH HALL, TATSFIELD on OCTOBER 24th 1962

A Parish Meeting was held at the Church Hall on
Oct. 24th 1962 at 8.30.p.m.

Present Dr. Richard Sturton in the chair with six Parish Council
the Clerk and 81 Parishioners.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, confirmed and
signed.

Matters Arising

A meeting was called to discuss the following resolution:

"That on the terms offered by the Charity-Commissioner
it is inadvisable to purchase or rent the Church Hall."

Dr. Sturton opened the meeting and gave a report of the
negotiations over the past two years between the Parish Council
and the Parochial Church Council concerning the Hall.

Mr. Rooney Pelletier then gave the views of the Church and
quoted the "Extract from the Parish Church Magazine of
Dec. 1908." He said there was no one, who did not agree that
the hall should continue as a village amenity. Mr. Pelletier
then gave figures showing the loss on the hall for the last
three years. A discussion took place and in replying to
questions Mr. Pelletier said that the Charity Commissioners
were willing to accept any proposal, which would be in a
ance with their duties to the original Charity. If the hall
was sold the proceeds would be reinvested with this in mind.
Mr. Pelletier then suggested that a small sub-committee with
three members from the Parish Council and three members from
the Parochial Church Council should be formed to seek ways and
means of maintaining a village hall. The sub-committee is to
make a report to a Parish Meeting to be held at a later date.
This was accepted and passed unanimously by the Meeting. There
being one dissenter.
