“This is a list of all the birds I’ve seen on the Crane over the last 8 years. Nearly all of these are visible every year. There are 53 in total. I suspect there’s a few species that are occasionally seen here that I’ve missed since the river will attract some displaced species at migration time. Although none of these species are exceptionally rare, the community itself is very unusual. Very few garden birdwatchers could expect such a rich feast!”
