JRE suggested that Leer sign be placed elsewhere as lorries back into it when drivers cannot come through the village and must turn around. Flooding under A417 Bridges: Abbots 11238918 Leer 11238921 Also 11238513 GCC ref FS Case 145540588: These soakaways have been cleared and worked well in recent storms. Damaged Road Sign at junction Notch Road / Ealy Hill: This had broken loose and was being blown into the road. Highways have removed it. Awaiting repair.

5) Finance

The current financial position is very close to budget. Savings have been made therefore the PC reinstated the donation to the CAB and approved the purchase of a dog waste bin for DA. The PC formally approved the Budget for 2020/21

6) Any Other Business

Planning Training - This will take place in March, JRE, EC and The Clerk will attend.
Parish Plan - The PC is considering developing a Community Design Statement.
Parish Emergency Plan - JRE, RE and The Clerk are in the process of updating this plan. The document identifies people who will coordinate help in the event of a local emergency or disaster which impacts a large number of people and carries risk to life, property or environment.

Dog Waste Bins - A dog waste bin wll be placed near the triangle in DA.

CDC Website States 'The Cotswold District Council Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO), makes it an offence if you do not remove any poo deposited by your dog. This removal must be done without delay. The order, made under the Anti- Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, applies to all public, open, land in the District whether or not warning signs are displayed. The PSPO also requires dog walkers to carry the means to pick up dog poo whilst on a walk. Any breach of the Order could result in a £100 fixed penalty notice or being taken to court and receiving a fine on conviction of up to £1000.'

The PC will purchase a waste bin for DL when location has been agreed. CDC will empty the bins on a regular basis.

Noticeboard in Leer – The PC discussed installing a glass fronted noticeboard in D Leer as leaflets and plastic coverings are being bown off of the current noticeboard.

The Grove Culvert The Grove has flooded again. There is significant history of this. The culvert is blocked by and damaged. The PC is investigating if this is the responsibility of Highways or landowners. The Chairman has written to Highways.
