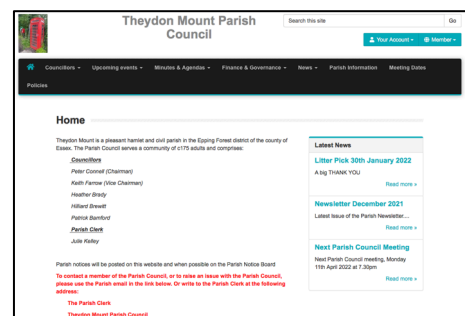



Ride London is a legacy event from the 2012 London Olympics and is coming to Essex on the **27th, 28th and 29th May 2022**. Ride London Classique, an elite ladies cycle race, will take place on Friday 27th in Maldon and on Saturday 28th will be cycling 2 laps around Theydon Mount so the Parish will have road side views of all the action!

On Sunday 29th May, Ride London Essex 100 will see 25,000 cyclists ride a 100 mile route around Essex. The event, described as the world’s greatest festival of cycling has been running since 2013 and has raised £12 million for charity.



RIDE LONDON ESSEX 100

Sunday 29 May 2022

- 100 mile event
- 65 miles in Essex
- Riders in Essex 0630 to 1700 in Essex
- 25,000 riders occupy 30 miles of road space when moving
- Fixed closures for entire course
- Sequenced closures between 0500 to 1800

There will be localised, temporary road closures on Saturday 28th May in Theydon Mount and significant road closures all day on Sunday 29th May in the surrounding area, in particular access roads to Epping or Ongar. As this may make a difference to your travel arrangements or impact your planned events over the weekend, please plan ahead.
