## CLERK'S REPORT

- 1. The new version of the Good Councillors' Guide was emailed to Councillors on 11 June for their future reference.
- 2. Following notification from NALC, details of the ACRE village hall building grants was emailed to TCS on 11 June 2024 for them to explore any opportunity for grant funding for the School Project.
- 3. The Redwood tree gifted from RVBC was planted in the field adjacent to Thornley School on 18 June 2024.
- 4. Councillors were informed about the Lancashire Constabulary and Lancashire Partnership Against Crime (LANPAC) invitation to the Crime Prevention Expo at the University of Central Lancashire (UCLan) on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> August.
- 5. Details regarding the Crime Commissioner welcoming applications from Community Safety Partnerships, local community groups, organisations, charities and Parish and Town Councils for projects that have a specific focus on preventing young people from engaging in crime and anti-social behaviour during the summer holiday period has been emailed to Councillors for information.
- 6. Clive Grunshaw, Lancashire Police and Crime Commissioner has launched his <u>Police and Crime Plan Public Consultation</u>. The survey is an opportunity for everyone who lives, works and travels in Lancashire to share feedback on crime and policing as well as the proposed priorities in the PCC's draft Police and Crime Plan 2024- 2029. Councillors were emailed with details on 12 July 2024.
