The man pictured above in the car also shown called at a dwelling house. He offered no ID and claimed to be from the Home Office investigating a breach of Covid regulations by someone entering the country and with a connection to this address (although he quoted a house name not recognised by the householder). **He has been reported to 101.** If he calls on you and fails to give a clear and sensible account of himself, call 999 to give Suffolk/Essex Police a chance to intercept him.

If he is genuine, but just slack on his ID procedure, Suffolk Police need to know.
