SUFFOLK POLICE TWITTER



Around 22:45hrs Tuesday 15th June a car cruised around a residential area of GREAT BRADLEY. It returned just before midnight & three men armed with baseball bats and wearing balaclavas jacked a car up and removed the catalytic converter. They made a loud noise, possibly when the targeted car dropped off a jack. They kept their car lights on during the theft. They seem prepared to meet any interference with force, so it is advisable not to intervene. The car they used was black (or a very dark colour) and, rather distinctively, the door frames appear to be red suggesting the car may have been subjected to an amateur re-paint at some stage.

If you spot a black saloon or hatchback driving slowly among parked cars in your village after dark, call 101, as this may enable the police response units to anticipate where the thieves will be operating next. If the 101 delay is long and you think the cruiser may indeed be scouting thieves, call 999. If you see any passenger from a car showing an interest in an otherwise unattended parked car after dark in your village, call 999. The police need to intercept the thieves on the road.
