ADVICE ON HOW TO SECURE YOUR UPVC DOORS.

In a number of Essex NW Districts recently there have been dwelling house burglaries due to UPVC doors not being properly locked.

Some offences have occurred overnight and the method the suspect(s) are using is 'popping' UPVC doors which have not been double locked.

It is essential that if you have a UPVC door that you double lock it.

Your UPVC door will be vulnerable if it is just shut not double locked.
