#### DWELLING HOUSE BURGLARIES AND ATTEMPTED BURGLARIES

##### BRAINTREE

##### Broad Road

January 14<sup>th</sup> between 19:45hrs and 19:50hrs

Suspect unknown gained access to the rear of victim's four bedroom detached house via a side gate and attempted to smash the glass and lock of the Bi Fold patio door from the kitchen to the garden. The outer pane of the double glazed door was shattered but the inner pane remained intact. So no entry gained.
