NATIONAL NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

In the past few months there have been a few people who have registered with National Neighbourhood Watch (which they are entilted to do of course) and may believe that they are "members" of Neighbourhood Watch.

Sadly National Neighbourhood Watch fail to advise them that if they live in Essex and want to be part of their local Neighbourhood Watch schemes they must be approved by the District Co-ordinator or at least by their local Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinator.

This is usually never a problem as most of the time we welcome everyone to Neighbourhood Watch.

It is important to remember that ONLY your Neighbourhood Watch Co-rdinators provide you with <u>local</u> Neighbourhood Watch information and Neighbourhood Watch items eg weekly and six monthly newsletters, window stickers, wheelie bin stickers, members guides, promotional pens, security door wedges, promotional key rings, 24 hour timers, and valid members badges, Nominated Neighbour Cards..

National Neighbourhood Watch never supply anyone with any of these items - <u>not even a</u> window sticker!

If you are accepted as being part of a <u>local scheme</u> you will also be covered under the Neighbourhood Watch Public Liability Insurance whenever you are on any Neighbourhood Watch activity. Also please also note that anyone who wants to be a local Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinator has to sign the appropriate form to state that they agree with the Neighbourhood Watch Code of Ethics. All very simple..thought that you should know!!!
