PERSONS CHARGED RELATING TO ALLEGATIONS INVOLVING CRUELTY TO A FOX



Two people have been charged in relation to allegations involving cruelty to a fox in the Coggeshall area on 4th December. One person 49 years old of Mount Bures, has been charged with hunting a wild mammal with dogs – an offence under the Hunting Act 2004 – and with causing unnecessary suffering to a protected animal – an offence under the Animal Welfare Act 2006.

A 16-year-old girl from the <u>Bures</u> area has also been charged with hunting a wild animal with dogs. The incident was reported to us and officers from our Rural Engagement Team launched an investigation.Both defendants appeared at Chelmsford Magistrates' Court on Wednesday 22 June.
