THEFT FOR A GARDEN SHED

There were too many criminal incidents to report in this week's newsletter but here are two:-

HALSTEAD The Causeway

Suspect unknown damaged a Ford vehicle by smashing the rear windscreen. The near side rear view mirror was also smashed and hanging off causing irreparable damage. A glass tomato sauce bottle with tomato sauce spread over the ground lying amongst the broken glass could have been used to break the windscreen.

Suspects unidentified threw rocks and stones at victim's fence.

ESSEX POLICE FACEBOOK: WITHAM

One male has been arrested on suspicion of burglary, along side a number of other offences following an incident this morning **October 6th** , Officers were called to Rowan Way in WITHAM **just before 3am** following reports of a car being stolen. Checks being completed whilst en route also identified that there may be another potential victim at a different location. Shortly after the initial 999 call, officers arrived at the scene and confirmed that a burglary had taken place. Quick enquiries also confirmed there to have been another burglary in Laburnum Way where another car had also been stolen around the same time. Quick actions by officers on scene along with support from other departments, air support and Met Police resulted in one of the stolen vehicles being stopped less than an hour after it had been stolen and one male was arrested, he remains in custody for questioning.

We are appealing for any witnesses who may have been in the area of Rowan Way or Laburnum Way to come forward if you saw or heard anything out of the ordinary during the early hours. We're also urging for residents of both roads who have CCTV, camera door bells or dash cams to check their footage to see if any activity overnight may support our investigation.
