#### HOW TO SECURE YOUR UPVC DOORS.

Some dwelling house burglaries occur due to UPVC doors not being properly locked.

These offences have been overnight and the method the suspect(s) are using is 'popping' UPVC doors which have not been double locked.

It is essential that if you have a UPVC door that you double lock it.

Your UPVC door will be vulnerable if it is just shut and not double locked.
