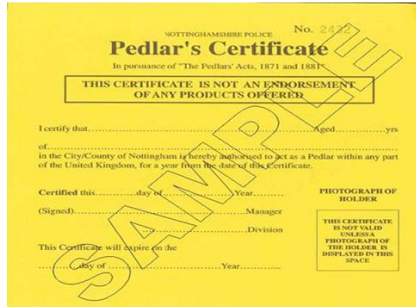

DID YOU KNOW ????



If anyone is selling any items at the door and wants to have payment at the time they must have a Pedlars Licence .

If they deny this then you know that they are not genuine..

This is a "draft Pedlars licence" approved by Essex Police Headquarters .

The licence is signed by a Senior Police Officer so can be easily checked

The best way is NEVER open the door to anyone you are not expecting..



Why not use the FREE Nominated Neighbour Card which anyone who feels vulnerable (at any age) will show at the time of the visit to the caller through the window , no need to speak just show the card..

The card ensures that those who have genuine reasons for calling will contact your Nominated Neighbour and explain why they are visting you.
