On **Wednesday 12th July** evening, undercover officers were patrolling the [River Walk Witham](#) .

During their patrol they spotted a man riding an electric motorbike on the footpath. The man was stopped and using the information passed to the police from the community the man was searched.

During the search, a large amount of cash and a quantity of what is suspected to be drugs were found . The man was arrested and another illegally ridden motorbike was taken off the paths .

Thursday 13th July Officers were called at **9.15pm.** to an aggravated burglary in [Warren Road Braintree](#) and arrested a man within 30 minutes of attending thanks to the help of members of the public.

The man was attempting to enter a property in using a knife. Officers were at the address 11 minutes after being called, and five police crews searched the area before finding and detaining a suspect within half an hour of arriving at the scene.

A 45-year-old man was arrested on suspicion of aggravated burglary and possession of an offensive weapon. He remains in custody.

Detective Chief Inspector Nathan Hutchinson said: "This is an excellent result for public safety, but could only be achieved thanks to the information provided by the public at the scene."

WHAT IS ESSEX POLICE DOG WATCH?



Dog Watch is an Essex Police led scheme. The aim is simple: it is to encourage Dog owners and walkers to be the additional eyes, ears and paws within the community and be part of the extended policing family.

Dog owners and walkers are familiar with the area in which they reside, and have the opportunity to spot anything out of place or suspicious whilst walking the dog. Dog walking takes place at all times during the day, during early evening and late at night, and it is during these times that suspicious activity maybe noted.

Dog owners also have the opportunity to report anything suspicious whilst walking further afield on days out, or whilst out and enjoying the countryside.
