THEFT OF A SCULPTURE



SUDBURY Old Market Place

Thursday 16th January between 21:21hrs and 21:30hrs

Police are appealing for witnesses after a bronze sculpture was damaged and then stolen from the Town Centre . The sculpture is a black metal Dalmation and was broken from a post outside the Town Hall before being placed in a bag and taken away . A group of three males and two females believed to be aged in their mid late teens were seen in the area at the time and are believed to have walked off with the sculpture.

PC John Moore said "Despite there being appeals this week in the media we are still asking for support from members of the public as we look to identify all parties involved in this incident.

We are also very keen to locate the sculpture which is an important celebration of Sudbury's heritage. Officers would like to speak to anyone with any information or who may have witnessed the incident or seen the group around at the time.

Two of the males were seen wearing dark clothing with one wearing light-coloured trainers and the other wearing light and dark trainers.

One female was wearing dark clothing the other was wearing light-cloured jeans and a white coat.
