ESSEX POLICE ARRESTS

SIBLE HEDINGHAM

Two people were arrested and drugs and firearms seized when officers executed a warrant.

The warrant, which was led by Braintree and Uttlesford neighbourhood policing team and supported by specialist and armed officers took place in the early hours of **Thursday 1st May**.

Once the arrests were made, a thorough search of the property took place, with officers uncovering: A cannabis grow, large quantities of pre-packed cannabis, a quantity of cocaine and crack cocaine four firearms, which are now being tested, and 9mm ammunition, a butterfly knife..

SUSPICIOUS PERSON AND ACTIVITY

Multiple sightings in the last few days in and around Hundon of possibly the same dodgy character(s)/vehicle.

A man with scarf covering the lower part of his face knocked very loudly at a front door and when the occupier answered the door he asked for directions to Sudbury (a highly improbable proposition given the location of the house).

Although the registration is invalid, his red van is plated as AV06 GWK.

Note: loud knocking can be used as a way to check whether there are dogs present even if an owner is absent.

Another Hundon resident reports arriving home to find a van, possibly the same vehicle as in the above incident, turning round in their drive and then driving off at speed.

In addition, two statues of sitting greyhound type dogs were stolen from a garden about half a mile away from Hundon during the week, **(most likely during the day on Wednesday 7 May)**.

The victim has been advised to report the theft to the police. *IF you see the person and van as described above please contact your local Essex/Suffolk Police.*
