WITHAM MAN ARRESTED FOR BURGLARY

COLCHESTER Howe Close

July 7th 21:30hrs

Officers were called to reports of someone trying to get into a property and were at the scene within minutes and arrested a 54 year old man from WITHAM at a short time later.

He was held in custody being questioned on suspicion of attempted burglary .

Detective Inspector Guy Turnbull said "We take home burglaries really seriously and last year secured two hundred charges for it.

We attend more than 99% of them and seen the number taking place fall by more than 25% with more than a thousand fewer across the county in the last year.

In this instance the swift response from Officers meant they were on the scene quickly and able to bring a suspect into custody..."
