Essex Police Rural Engament Officerss have stepped up patrols in areas known to attract hare coursers as the good weather means the season has started early

Recently Essex Police were out near <u>Bradwell</u> patrolling in marked and unmarked vehicles and using their drones to check out large areas of land difficult to access on foot and in a police vehicle.

Sgt Paul Brady says "We rely on reports from the public to helop us targett our operational activity If you don't tell us, we don't know what is happening If you see any hare coursing taking place please ring 999 and report a crime in progress Please provide as much information as you can including a precise location but dotn put yourself at risk

Four people from Basildon, Wickford & Birstal (Leicestershire) have been charged with hare coursing offences following a Rural Engagement Team investigation...
