MAN ARRESTED IMITATION FIREARM

WITHAM

Monday 1st December

A man has been arrested and charged following an incident in involving an imitation firearm.

Information was passed to us by members of the community, which allowed officers to act swiftly and ensure the community remained safe.

As a result of this investigation, a 55-year-old man was arrested and later charged in connection with the incident.

He was taken straight to court on Thursday 4th December where he was remanded in custody.

His next hearing is scheduled for January at Chelmsford Crown Court.

Essex Police say "We want to thank everyone who came forward and shared vital information.

Your vigilance and support play a crucial role in helping us keep our communities safe.

MAN ARRESTED FOR SUPPLYING COCAINE

LITTLE BRAXTED Kelvedon Road



A man was arrested by officers by keen-eyed Maldon Neighbourhood Policing officers and has been sentenced for supplying cocaine. The man aged 24, was spotted by the officers in <u>Kelvedon Road</u> on 11 June 2025 and they stopped him shortly afterwards in <u>Carters Lane</u>.

As they caught up with his car, the man was seen throwing a package out of the window into undergrowth at the side of the lane. The officers recovered the package, which contained £400 of cocaine in deal wraps, and a search of the car revealed two mobile phones and £215 in the msn's wallet. At a previous court hearing, the man of Green Lane, Wixams in Bedfordshire, admitted possession with intent to supply cocaine and he was sentenced on 27 November at Chelmsford Crown Court.



Officers in Braintree are looking to trace the owner of some distinctive items, believed to have possibly been stolen from a burglary.

The items, pictured below, were found by a member of the public in the garden of a licenced premises on <u>Coggeshall Road</u>, <u>Braintree</u> on the evening of Saturday 29th November 2025.
