We're open 24/7, 365 days a year. Crimestoppers passed over 7,500 crime reports to Essex police last year.

NWN AND BRAINTREE DISTRICT NW

Every so often people register with Neighbourhood Watch Network.(NWN) and even create a local NW scheme (on the NWN database which the scheme , by the way , must be approved by their local District Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinator as advise dby NWN!

Now this is fine..to register with NWN.....

As NWN are brilliant in promoting and supporting registered and approved NW schemes in England and Wales. They also provide many workshops to discuss crime prevention advice and also how to be an effective Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinator which is of course is great..(See the Members Guide for more information)

However I have access to the NWN database and see those who register on NWN and an email is sent to introduce Braintree NW as we distribute local NW information from reliable sources and also provide many FREE NW items not just window stickers ,wheelie binstickers or No Colf Caller stickers.

What surprises me is that, at times, we never hear from those who have been emailed or we posted any information to them

It gives us the impression that they do not seem to want to be part of NW where they live..which is their choice (of course) or in fact have their scheme approved (very strange as it is mandatory by NWN)....

So by not contating us they will never receive any local NW information and (this is important) they cannot state to their Home Insurance Companies that they are "Members of local NW" . As being registered with NWN is not appropriate to say that you are a"Member of local NW" So leave that thought with you ..
