WOMAN CHARGED FOLLOWING SHIPLIFTING INCIDENT

BRAINTREE VILLAGE

Between Saturday 3rd January to Sunday 4th January

A 38-year-old woman has been charged after reports of shoplifting .

She faces charges of:

Shoplifting (valued at around £200)

Going equipped to steal after a foil-lined bag was found .

Assault after a security officer was punched during the incident,

The woman was remanded in police custody and appeared in court, where she was given strict bail conditions, including not entering Braintree.

She is due to return to court at a later date.

Essex Police say..

Reports of shoplifting in Braintree are down 27% compared to last year, but we continue to work closely with local shops and security teams to reduce this even further.

RISING TREND: NUMBER PLATE THEFTS

"We've seen an increase in number plates being stolen from cars across the district. While this isn't a new crime, we want to raise awareness and help you protect your vehicle.

Why do thieves steal plates?

Stolen plates are often used to disguise vehicles involved in crime, such as fuel theft or avoiding speed cameras. Occasionally, they're even taken for unusual reasons—like being used under skateboards.

How to reduce the risk:

- Use anti-theft screws or security bolts for your plates.
- Park in well-lit, busy areas or a secure garage whenever possible.
- Consider CCTV or dash cams for added deterrence.
- Report any suspicious activity immediately to the police."
