BUSINESS BURGLARY

GREAT CORNARD Canhams Road

Two unknown offenders forced entry into The Co-Op via the front door and they broke into the cigarette kiosk and stole a quantity of tobacco products.

COMMON EXAMPLE OF COURIER FRAUD

- Phone call out of the blue
- Claims to be your bank or police
- Advises of an issue with your card
- Asks for your PIN
- Sends courier to collect your card

Unsure whether a caller is genuine?

Hang up , wait a minute , then call them back on a **KNOWN** number to verify their identity.

Also never click on emails which says a courier company needs to deliver a package at any time as the attachment could be a virus!

Delete it immediately!
