# ESSEX POLICE TWITTER

Essex Police have arrested thirteen people and two county lines have been taken out during a series of dawn raids in various areas in Essex including Braintree.

It is the culmination of a seven-month-long operation to target criminals involved in county lines drugs gangs. Warrants under the Misuse of Drugs Act were executed at several addresses in the early hours. Suspected class A drugs, a four figure sum of cash and a stun gun have been seized.

Detective Chief Inspector Paul Wells said: "A team of detectives has been working over the last seven months to gather evidence against criminals selling illegal drugs and exploiting vulnerable people in our communities. "This operation is an example of the extensive and varied work that officers are doing every day to make Essex a hostile place for criminals who seek to sell drugs and exploit vulnerable people in our communities. "We are committed to doing everything we can to take robust action against these criminal groups and any other individuals who try to fill the gap left by county lines that we dismantle."
