ADVICE ON HOW TO SECURE UPVC DOORS.

There have been a number of dwelling house burglaries over the past weeks and may have been due to Upvc doors not being locked properly.

Some offences have occurred overnight and the method the suspect(s) are using is 'popping' UPVC doors which have not been double locked.

It is essential that if you have a UPVC door that you double lock it.

Your UPVC door will be vulnerable if it is just shut not double locked.
