ARRESTED AND CHARGED FOR DWELLING HOUSE BURGLARY

HAVERHILL Downton Drive

Sunday April 26th.

Suffolk Police have arrested and charged, on May 3rd, a twenty year old man for a dwelling house burglary and taking a Samsung television, games consoles, a samurai sword, an ornamental knife, a Bose speaker, camera equipment and cash.

He was subsequently remanded after his appearance at Ipswich Magistrates Court on May 4th.

THEFT FROM PERSONS

BRAINTREE Charter Way

Between May 7th 20:20hrs and May 8th 21:13hrs.

Suspect unknown removed victim's mobile phone.

WITHAM Newland Street

May 4th between 12:30hrs and 13:26hrs.

Suspect unknown stole purse from victim's bag which was over her shoulder.

BOCKING Rayne Road

THEFT AND ATTEMPTED THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLES

COLNE ENGAINE

Green Farm Road (1) Between May 7th 21:00hrs and May 8th 08:32hrs. Suspect unknown gained entry to victim's silver Citroen Dispatch by smashing the rear nearside window - no items removed
