Thursday 13th June 15:30hrs.

A man knocked on the door of a woman in her 70's and began discussing ground works at her home. Two other men entered the victim's home and left with a four figure sum of cash.

ADVICE ON HOW TO SECURE UPVC DOORS.

There have been dwelling house burglaries due to UPVC doors not being locked properly.

Some offences have occurred overnight and the method the suspect(s) are using is 'popping' UPVC doors which have not been double locked.

It is essential that if you have a UPVC door that you double lock it.

Your UPVC door will be vulnerable if it is just shut not double locked.
