Although the Parish Council can only comment on Planning Applications their comments are taken seriously by the planners. They are the voice of the community and should reflect the consensus view of our villages. In order for this procedure to work effectively an agreed and resolved Planning Policy is proposed.

Toppesfield Parish Council's Planning Policy is:

Toppesfield Parish Council will object to any greenfield development.

It will consider any infill development on its merits both inside and outside the village envelope.

Affordable housing development to address the need of the villages will receive special consideration and generally be supported by the Parish Council.

The Parish Council will hold public meetings to discuss applications considered to be controversial. Such meetings will be called either by the Parish Council or at the request of five or more residents.
