12TH JUNE 2017

Open Forum: TWRA welcomed the new Surrey Police & Crime Commissioner, Mr David Munro. He went onto detail his responsibilities and those of Surrey Police.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting: These were approved and signed by the Chairman.

Matters Arising from the Previous Meeting: These were discussed and where action was required, it had been taken.

County Councillor's Report: Cllr. Few advised that work is due to started o the refurbishment of the Runnymede Roundabout. He confirmed that he had been reappointed with the responsibility for Adult Social Care.

Chairman's Comments: He advised that he had been unable to contact Solette Shepherdson of the Surrey Volunteer Sector – he will endeavour to contact her.

Secretary's Report: This was distributed prior to the meeting.

Treasurer's Report: **This** report was distributed prior to the meeting. The matter regarding the subscription from a resident who lives outside the Ward was discussed.

Councillors' Reports: EG distributed her report prior to the meeting. MH advised that she had attended many of the same meetings as EG however she added that RBC have employed an organization named Kingdom Enforcement Services (KIPS) whose responsibility it is to fine anyone dropping litter. There is an on-the-spot fine of £75 e.g. dropping cigarette ends, dog-fouling etc. LG advised that Lyne Residents are in the process of setting up a Residents' Association.

Town Planning: H advised of the past month's planning applications. There were a couple of concerns that will be raised with RBC.

Milton Park Farm: Hanson's application has been delayed until 13th September 2017.

Neighbourhood Forum: The next meeting will be held in July.

Social Media: We continue to receive "Likes".

Thorpe Together: Thanks were extended to MH for getting the latest issue prepared and arranged for distribution. It was unanimously agreed that additional volunteers are required to help with the distribution.
