




FOOD PANTRY STAMFORD HILL

Wednesday: 9:15 -3:45 / Thursday: 9:15 -3:45
The Pantry offers high-quality, nutritious and healthy food at an affordable price for those struggling with food costs and empowers individuals and families to overcome barriers they face. The pantry runs every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from Southern Housing's Stamford Hill Community Centre. For a membership subscription of £3.50 per week, you can access a wide range of fresh fruit and vegetables, as well as refrigerated, frozen, and shelf food and drinks. St. Giles delivers the pantry, and their knowledgeable and experienced staff provide impartial information, advice and support from their trained peer advisers should you need it. The food distributed by the Pantry is sustainably sourced and is helping to reduce supermarket food waste.
