	$\checkmark$	working within the requirements of relevant data protection legislation
Safe by:	$\checkmark$	following good health and safety practice
	$\checkmark$	paying attention to our own and other's safety
	$\checkmark$	raise any health and safety issues immediately
Fair by:	$\checkmark$	being objective and open-minded
	$\checkmark$	declaring any conflicts of interest
