Overview


- The scheme is the second phase of capacity improvements to the southern A326 and B3053 ahead of the proposed Fawley Waterside development.
- This second phase of works includes capacity, pedestrian and cycling improvements to
 - B3053 / Blackfield Road / Church Lane
 - A326 Applemore Roundabout
- This scheme supports Hampshire County Council's Waterside Transport Strategy and complements local Transforming Cities Funded and Local Cycling Walking and Infrastructure Plans.
- ➤ A third phase of works to the Heath Roundabout is being planned to follow the completion of the second phase.

Objectives

- > Reduce traffic congestion and increase capacity;
- > Improve network resilience;
- > Improve connectivity for Waterside communities;
- Protect the New Forest rural environment by improving A326 capacity to keep traffic on the main routes during peak times;
- Encourage active travel;



Widening of approaches and exit lanes, realignment of the National Cycle Network crossing of A326


B3053 Church Lane/Blackfield Rd




6. A326 Applemore Roundabout Traffic Management Plan






7. B3053 / Blackfield Road / Church Lane, Fawley






8. B3053 / Blackfield Road / Church Lane - Road Closure






9. B3053 / Church Lane / Blackfield Road - Three-way Lights

11. Ecology and Environment

Ecology and Environment

- The scheme is in an environmentally sensitive area, with some junctions within / adjacent to the New Forest National Park / New Forest Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) / Special Protection Area (SPA) / Ramsar and Special Area of Conservation (SAC).
- Extended ecological surveys were carried out in August 2019, March 2021 and renewed April 2023.
- Additional noise and archaeology environmental surveys have been carried out.
- Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) screening was undertaken in line with the EIA Regulations 2017.
- Habitats Regulations Assessment (HRA) was carried out due to presence of environmentally designated sites.
- All construction works must be undertaken in accordance with the Construction Environmental Management Plan (CEMP) which has been approved by NFNPA and Natural England.
