

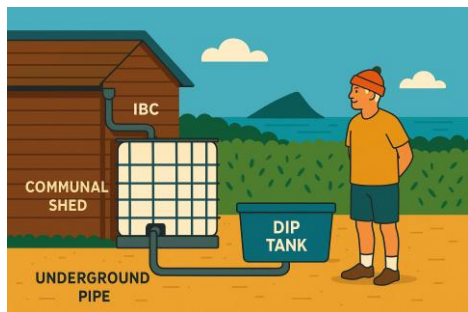

Hello fellow gardeners. Here is our latest information update!

Water and Good Will



August can be a demanding month for us; heat, fast-growing crops, and no mains water mean that every bit of supply counts. Rain from the **communal shed roof** is collected in **IBCs**, (repurposed Intermediate Bulk Containers) which feed the **dip tanks** around the site. Many plot holders also rely on **water butts**, or their own IBCs.

Massive thanks go to **Pete Bromley**, our **Water Steward**, who keeps the system running, clearing blockages, checking levels, and spotting problems early. We recommend at least two water butts per plot, with full guidance in the tenancy agreement and on the website. In a dry summer, it's not just about water, it's about everyone doing their bit to manage it well.

Locals walking through the Wembury Allotments can now vote for their favourite plot. A laminated plan and voting slips are in the excess veg box just inside the gate to the "Rec"; write down the number of the plot you think is the best and post it in the box. (Committee plots are marked with an X and not included.) It's a small, friendly way to show appreciation for the time and care people put into their growing. At the end of the season, these votes will help decide our *Plot of the Year*, with the winner awarded the RHS **Banksian Medal**. So, if you're passing through, why not join in?
