

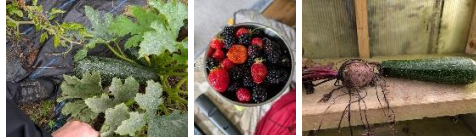

November is an important time as we plan for the next growing season.

Seasonal planting has been underway since October, with garlic, onions, and broad beans being sown on some plots to overwinter and provide early harvests next year.

Composting continues through the winter months, with a mix of green waste from the summer runner beans etc and dry leaves helping to create rich compost for the spring.
