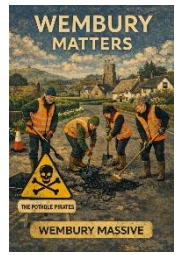

Water Save Project



This project, for which we received a grant from South West Water, is now complete. We have achieved a total of 33 IBCs, giving us 33,000 litres of water storage on site. This is vital for us, with no mains water supply. As part of the project, several ageing IBCs were replaced and have since been sold on to plot holders, who are repurposing them for their own individual water supplies. Jan Jefferis for all their hard work, which has clearly paid off.
