Proposed Community Space at Wembury Allotments



The WAA Committee is considering the creation of a new community space within a current wild area of the site, which measures about 35 metres by 7.5 metres. One idea is that we could introduce a series of raised beds that could be used by people who would



find a larger allotment plot too demanding, or who just want a taste of allotmenting! The area could be divided into several smaller sections, including at least one with wheelchair access.
