#### CHANGES TO FREE SCHOOL MEAL VOUCHERS

Following the Department for Work and Pensions announcement of <u>Household Support</u> <u>Fund 4</u>, the council announced there will still be significant support to those families in receipt of free school meals in Essex.

This year there will be some minor changes to allocations and timings of payments. This is due to the fact families in receipt of free school meals will be receiving additional support from the government's cost of living payments.

Allocations per child for 2023 will have a total value of £150 paid in three stages outlined below:

- May £15
- July £75
- December £60

# **GOVERNMENT EXTENDS £2 SINGLE BUS FARE**



Travelling by bus continues to be affordable with single fare tickets costing just £2 allowing passengers to travel across Essex, exploring its vibrant cities, picturesque

countryside and charming towns.

All you need to do is ask your bus driver for a single ticket then sit back and enjoy your bus journey. Before you travel make sure to check your route is eligible for the £2 single fare on the <u>Government website</u>. The £2 rate will run to 31 October 2023.

The capped single fare will then be extended for at least another year at £2.50 until 30 November 2024 – when the government will review their effectiveness and future bus fares.


Town and parish councils, community groups, social enterprises and individuals can apply now.

# CONSULTATION OPEN FOR THE NEW TRANSPORT STRATEGY FOR THE MALDON DISTRICT



Residents, businesses, and visitors to Maldon are being encouraged to have their say on the future of travel in the district.

The new Maldon District Future Transport Strategy, created by Essex County Council in partnership with Maldon District Council, sets out the current transport issues and opportunities in the district, as well as a strategy for how transport schemes will be approached in the future.

There is a high reliance on car use in the district due to its rural and coastal nature and fragmented bus and cycle networks. There is potential to encourage a shift towards using more sustainable types of transport for short journeys through the town, as well as longer distance journeys for those living and working in surrounding areas.

#### CONSULTATION ON SUPPORTED LOCAL BUS SERVICES 2024-2028

Essex County Council have launched their Supported Local Bus Services 2024 - 2028 consultation. Bus services are important to many of our residents and communities, so participation by as many as possible would be greatly appreciated:

- Consultation is open now until 5<sup>th</sup> October 2023. We are consulting on 3 groups of services:
  - o The vast majority where we are proposing no change until at least 2028
  - o An 'at risk' group which we will support until at least 2026 but where we are looking for an increase in passenger numbers
  - o A low use group which are clearly not meeting the needs of communities
