First floor providing bedroom accommodation and a bathroom, with 4 No. dormers to increase head height on upper floor.

The Council understands the conversion of the garage to provide accommodation for family members would aid farming activities to continue at the property and provide fundamental family community ties within the village. The conversion would not appear to have a negative impact in character and amenity in the lane and Cllrs resolved to SUPPORT the application.
