Minutes of the Meeting of Wotton Parish Council held at 7pm on Tuesday 3 October 2023 in Wotton Village Hall

Present: Cllrs Andy Cole (in the Chair), David Mir, Daniel Bennett

In Attendance: Mrs Janet Hunt, the Clerk

- Apologies for absence: Cllrs Peter Evelyn, Laurence Matthews, Steve Hackett; SCC Cllr Hazel Watson, MVDC Cllrs Chris Budleigh, Abhiram Magesh, Leah Mursaleen-Plank.
- **Election of Vice Chairman:** Cllr Mir proposed Cllr Cole for Vice Chairman, Cllr Bennett seconded the proposal. This was agreed by all and Cllr Cole was duly elected as Vice Chairman.
- 3 **Co-option of new Councillor:** Cllr Cole proposed that Mrs Janet Hunt be coopted as a member of the Council, Cllr Mir seconded the proposal, all present agreed and Mrs Hunt was duly co-opted onto the Parish Council.
- 4 Declarations of interest relating to matters on this agenda: None.
- 5 Public questions: None (see item 9).
- 6 Minutes of Meeting held on 4 July 2023: Cllr Bennett asked if there were any further responses about the application by the owners of the Stephan Langton Inn to change to residential use, which had been noted in the minutes of the last meeting. The clerk said there had been no comments after councillors had looked at the detailed documents. There followed a brief discussion about the difficulties of running the pub in such a remote location, shortage of parking on site, and the recent steep rise in the cost of living. The Minutes of the meeting were proposed for acceptance by Cllr Mir, seconded by Cllr Cole, and agreed by all present. The Minutes were signed by Cllr Cole.
- **Police report:** (Annex 1) Noted. The clerk said she had written to the police to ask for more details of the locations and dates of incidents in future reports.
- 8 Planning:
 - (i) Applications/decisions: (Annex 2) Noted.
 - (ii) Gatwick expansion: Cllr Cole had attended a presentation at Capel about the proposed Gatwick northern runway extension. Representatives of the Gatwick Area Consultative Committee spoke about the proposal. They are particularly concerned about environmental issues. The proposed new runway would be moved 10 yards and extended. It will remain within the boundaries of the existing site. This will enable one runway to be used for take-offs and the other runway for landing, which will mean less waiting time and be safer than using only one runway for incoming and outgoing aircraft.

The extended runway will also allow more of the larger aircraft to use the airport, although most of the big A380s will continue to land at Heathrow. A big increase in passenger numbers is being planned for. Flight routes will not change for Wotton. Cllr Bennett said the expansion will mean a need for more houses and more roads. The public consultation ends on 29 October. - 9 Highways: Cllr Bennett said traffic cones had been left in bushes along Coast Hill and asked the clerk to contact Mole Valley about removing them. There has been dumping of fridges and glass in Walpoles. Cllr Hunt suggested taking photos of areas where dumping/fly tipping is happening so that it can be reported. Cllr Cole said the bank is coming apart alongside Ranmore Common Road after the heavy rains and is now causing a dangerous obstruction on the highway that should be reported to Surrey Highways. The clerk said a report would be made.
- **Approve/revise statutory documents:** Standing Orders, Code of Conduct, Financial Regulations, Risk Assessment. The clerk said she had reviewed these statutory documents and no amendments were necessary (see website www.e-voice.org.uk/wottonpc.)

11 Reports:

(i) The clerk said Mole Valley District Council is currently undertaking a public consultation on its Strategy for 2024-2028.

Cllr Cole said he had completed the survey on the website (https://molevalley.gov.uk/strategyconsultation). He was concerned about regeneration of the town centre which has many empty shops now. If landlords could be persuaded to move shop units together in one area to make it more convenient for shoppers, this would enable the remaining premises to be changed to residential use. It was suggested that some national retailers are unable to come to Dorking because there are no large retail units available. Cllr Hunt said the problem was that rentals are very high. Cllr Bennett said parking was also a problem in Dorking. Cllr Cole suggested writing to MVDC about empty shop units being changed to residential use.

Cllr Hunt said a big problem now in Dorking, following closure of all the bank branches, is the loss of ATM machines. This is causing her neighbours distress because she takes them to Dorking to withdraw cash and the only ATM machine in Dorking high street is outside the Nationwide Building Society. The branch is only open 3 days a week and the ATM machine is frequently out of cash for extended periods. The clerk said she would write to MVDC to ask if any progress is being made on opening a banking hub which would include an ATM.

Cllr Cole recommended that everyone completes the Strategy Survey. **Final date for submission is Sunday 5 November.**

(ii) The clerk said a request for a VAT refund for the period since 29 September 2022 is being sent to HMRC. The auditors recommended making VAT claims annually.

12 Finance:

- (i) Sign Exemption Certificate: At the external auditor's request, the clerk had submitted, for a second year, a full Annual Governance and Accountability Return 2022-23 (Form 3) for a full review. PKF have now said this is not necessary, a Certificate of Exemption (Form 2) can be submitted instead. This was signed by Cllr Cole.
- (ii) Approve payments: Cllr Cole proposed, Cllr Mir seconded, and all agreed the payments be approved. The list of payment attached to invoices was signed by Cllr Cole and Cllr Mir. (Annex 3)
- (iii) Sign bank statement: The statements were signed by Cllr Cole and Cllr Mir.
- (iv) Income and expenditure update: The clerk said no unbudgeted expenditure had been made this year and there was a small fund available for expenditure on community projects. It was suggested that equipment to aid litter-picking, long handled clippers etc, would be useful. The clerk was asked to get some prices for consideration at the next meeting. There is a lot of bracken on footpaths, and it was suggested that everyone note which footpaths are overgrown and need dealing with so that reports can be made to SCC. There was also the suggestion that more dog waste bins would be useful as so many people leave bags hanging on trees and bushes and forget to take them home after walking their dogs.
